Established for over 30 years, ASM Auto Recycling is widely regarded as one of the UK's most modern and professional vehicle salvage agents and parts recyclers.

At present we process over 30,000 end-of-life vehicles every year and specialise in online salvage auctions, with over 2,500 damage-repairable and stolen-recovered cars, vans and bikes available for purchase every week.

We also have an extensive used car parts department. With over 1,500 vehicles stored at our premises for vehicle dismantling, we can supply recycled car parts for most makes and models of vehicles to anywhere in the UK and across the world.

Concern for the environment is an integral and fundamental part of ASM's corporate business strategy. The core business activity is the sale of vehicles and parts that can be salvaged and re-used, thus extending the lifecycle of the item and improving the overall environmental impact of manufacture.

Certification to the internationally recognised standard for Environmental Management (ISO14001:2015) is the basis for the implementation of a robust environmental management system.

We will work to continually improve the company's performance and associated management systems to realise our care and responsibility for the environment.
